PRIVACY POLICY

TikalBayTek, Inc. (the “Company”) is committed to protecting the privacy of our users. This privacy policy explains when and how personal information is collected, used, disclosed and protected with respect to our website located at www.tikalbaytek.com (the “Website”), and any mobile device software application (a “Mobile App”), website, web widgets, feeds and applications for third-party websites and services, and any other mobile or web services or applications owned, controlled, or offered by the Company (collectively, including the Website and any Mobile App, the “Network”). By using the Network, you consent to the privacy practices described in this Privacy Policy, as modified from time to time by us. Please carefully review this policy so you understand our data privacy practices.

This Privacy Policy is incorporated into and is subject to the TikalBayTek Terms of Service. Your use of the Website, a Mobile App, or any other part of our Network and any personal information you provide on the Network remains subject to our Terms of Service. Any capitalized terms not defined in this Privacy Policy shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Terms of Service.

WHAT IS PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Personal information is information that specifically identifies an individual, such as a name, address, telephone number, email address, or other account number, and information about that individual’s activities when directly linked to that person, such as information about his or her use of the Network. Personal information also includes demographic information, such as date of birth, gender, geographic location and preferences when such information is linked to other personal information that identifies you. Personal information does not include “aggregate” information. Aggregate information is data we collect about a group or category of products, services or customers, from which individual customer identities have been removed. In other words, information about how you use a service may be collected and combined with information about how others use the same service. Aggregate data helps us understand trends and our users’ needs so that we can better consider new features or otherwise tailor the Network.

PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW WE USE IT

Our Mobile Apps do not collect any personal information about the user. We only collect personal information when you contact us by email for any reason. Also, when you visit the Website, some information is automatically collected, such as your computer’s Internet Protocol (IP) address, your computer’s operating system, the browser type, the address of a referring website, and the time and date of your visit. We treat this information as personal information if we combine it with or link it to any of the identifying information mentioned above.

SHARING OF YOUR INFORMATION

In addition, we may disclose personal information in the good faith belief that we are lawfully authorized to do so, or that doing so is reasonably necessary to comply with legal process or authorities, respond to any claims, or to protect the rights, property or personal safety of the Company, our users, our employees or the public. Information about our users, including personal information, may be disclosed or transferred as part of, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets or acquisition.

CONTROL OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

At any time parents of minors can refuse to permit us to collect further personal information from their child and can request that any personal information we have collected be deleted from our records.

COOKIES, IP ADDRESSES AND URLS

Automatically Collected Information: We automatically receive certain types of information whenever you interact with us. When you access our Website or otherwise use any part of our Network except for our Mobile Apps, we collect (i) certain technical information about your mobile device or computer system, including MAC Address, IP Address and mobile device ID; and (ii) usage statistics about your interactions with the Network. This information is typically collected through the use of server log files or web log files (“Log Files”), mobile device software development kits and tracking technologies like browser cookies to collect and analyze certain types of technical information. We also collect various types of “clickstream” information which is information about your browsing behavior, such as IP address information, entry and exit points for the Network, search terms, website addresses you visit, page views, and impressions

Cookies: Cookies are small text files placed on your hard drive by a website when you visit. These files identify your computer and record your preferences and other data about your visit so that when you return to the Network, the network knows who you are and can personalize your visit. In general, we use cookies to collect information so that we can complete transactions you have requested and improve and personalize the Network experience by seeing which areas and features are most popular. Most browsers automatically accept cookies as the default setting. You can modify the setting to reject cookies or to prompt you before accepting a cookie from the sites you visit by editing browser options. If you decide not to accept our cookies, you will still be able to access those parts of the Network available to the general public but you may not be able to use some of the network’s features or services, and you may have a less satisfactory experience.

Our Mobile Apps do not access the Internet for any reason during the use of the apps and do not collect any cookies or other automatically collected information. Our Mobile Apps do not use any third party software for analytics or any other purposes.

USE OF THE NETWORK BY CHILDREN

We encourage parents to take an active interest in their children’s use of the Network. We do not intend to collect personal information from children who are under 13 years of age. If you are under 13 you should not provide information on the Network. Further, we strongly encourage parents and guardians to supervise the activity of all children under the age of 18.

TikalBayTek is committed to making its Mobile Apps safe and secure for children. Accordingly, our Mobile Apps do not collect personal information, do not have any ads, do not provide an opportunity for in-app purchases, do not include any push-notifications, and do not contain any integration with Facebook, Twitter, or any other social media sites or services.

LINKS TO OTHER WEBSITES

Our Mobile Apps do not contain any links to other apps or other websites, however other parts of our Network, may contain links to other websites. Any personal information you provide on the linked pages is provided directly to that third party and is subject to that third party's privacy policy. Except as described above, we are not responsible for the content or privacy and security practices and policies of websites to which we link. Links from the Network to third parties or to other sites are provided for your convenience. We encourage you to learn about their privacy and security practices and policies before providing them with personal information.

SITE DEVELOPMENT

THE NETWORK IS UNDER CONTINUOUS DEVELOPMENT AND TESTING BY THE COMPANY. THE NETWORK MAY CONTAIN BUGS AND OTHER ERRORS THAT COULD ADVERSELY AFFECT THE USE OR PERFORMANCE OF THE NETWORK.
